



Ahmedabad Medicity to Get Rs 295 Crore Spine and Sports Injury Centre

To address the rising burden of spinal-related diseases in Gujarat and meet the healthcare demands of upcoming global sporting events, a world-class Spine Institute, Sports Injury Centre and Rehabilitation Centre equipped with international-standard facilities will be established at Ahmedabad Medicity at an estimated cost of Rs. 295 crore, the Gujarat government said today.
